
#### Road to Energy Efficiency

- Plan for the Future
- Site-Specific Analysis
  - let a study drive decisions, not industry standards
- Ancillary Benefits
  - comfort, health, local law compliance, fuel conversions, etc.





Stages to Improve Your Building



1. Assess

2. Implement

3. Measure



#### **Assess**

- Pre-Qualified Energy Consultant
  - energy assessment to evaluate upgrades
- Comprehensive Evaluation
  - required saving opportunities to analyze
- Select Improvements
  - Only requirement: ≥15% in savings

#### **Implement**

- Contract with NYSERDA
  - agree to install a number of measures
- 50% Completion Inspection
- Substantial Inspection
  - one year deadline from contract





#### Measure

- Post-Construction Benchmarking
  - ensure project and program success
- Compare Projected vs. Actual Savings
- Reduce Energy Use, Save Money
  - project's savings accrue each year





# **Program Incentives**

upon approval of:

- 1.comprehensive energy assessment
- 2.scope of work projected to achieve ≥15% annual energy savings
- 3.complete installation of scope of work

\$500-\$1000/unit\*

\*depending upon market type and fuel use

#### Program to Date

- Launched in 2007
  - worked/working with over 177,000 units
  - nearly 50,000 units have completed a comprehensive scope of work
  - offering existing, and NC programs
- Program Extended through 2015






# **Program Savings**
