Workshops will explore a wide variety of topics, including several on the intersection between healthcare reform and supportive housing - working with MCOs, how to find and house high-cost Medicaid recipients as well as a new model weaving on-site healthcare into supportive housing services; development and financing panels featuring innovative upstate and downstate models; a raft of workshops for staff including an Evidence Based Practice for hoarding, modifying supportive housing as tenants age, how to support staff, and using story-telling and meditation in working with tenants. The conference will also feature panels on ending veteran homelessness, a city policy discussion on approaches to ending homelessness and new opportunities for re-entry housing.

The conference will include forums featuring nearly all the City and State agency leaders that work in the ever-growing supportive housing field, giving participants an opportunity to discuss emerging policies that will impact our community.
