Every year, the Supportive Housing Network of New York honors 1-2 supportive housing tenants with the coveted **Tenant of the Year Award** at our Annual Awards Gala. This year the gala will take place on October 14, 2015 from 6pm-9pm at Capitale, 130 Bowery in New York City. This special event is expected to attract over 600 attendees.

The Tenant of the Year winner will receive a \$200.00 gift certificate and be recognized at the gala and on the Network's website and social media. Tenants of the Year attend the gala as our guests. Travel and lodging for out-of-town winners may be provided upon request.

Why **nominate someone** or **encourage a tenant to apply**? This is an amazing opportunity to tell your story and to help and inspire the supportive housing community. We are looking for **tenants who have made a difference** in their own lives and in their supportive housing residence. We want to learn how he or she utilized supportive housing to its fullest capacity to improve his or her life. We want to share the winner's story and celebrate their success!

We request that each non-profit agency nominate only one tenant per site/program. We ask that you please nominate a tenant who has lived in Supportive Housing for at least a year, defined as: a residence or scattered site apartment program where the tenants may stay as long as they like; their tenancy is protected by a lease or lease –like agreement; their tenancy is not contingent upon acceptance/compliance of services; services are offered on-site in the building or in the case of scattered site, directly in the tenant's home. Prior years' nominees are welcome to re-apply.

### Requirements:

- Two letters of references from the agency on behalf of the tenant from a case manager, social worker, program director or fellow resident
- A 500 words or less typed narrative that includes concrete examples of the individual's accomplishments and the role supportive housing played in these accomplishments, along with descriptions/examples of the qualities of character that distinguish the nominee
- A nomination consent form completed by the tenant (see attached)
- An electronic photograph of tenant
- Tenant availability and willingness to accept the award at the gala

Winners will be chosen by a Network staff committee by the end of August. Nominations are due by August 14<sup>th</sup> and should be sent to <u>emartinez@shnny.org</u>.
