Include the legislator's handle (if they have one, it will be on the meeting schedule), your organization's handle, @theNetworkNY or @thenetworkny.bsky.social and hashtags #savesupportivehousing and/or #NetworkLobbyDay25. The Network will be posting on BlueSky and Instagram throughout the day.

#Supportivehousing is a proven tool to combat chronic homelessness. The 2025-26 budget is an opportunity for @GovKathyHochul and the NY State legislature to preserve existing units and expand supportive housing capacity.

Everyone deserves a safe and stable home. #Suppotivehousing can END chronic homelessness, but only if @GovKathyHochul and the NY state legislature properly invest in preserving and expanding it in the 2025-2026 budget.

Nonprofits cannot operate effectively when they are waiting on late payments from government contracts. For #supportivehousing to reach its full potential, the City and State must ensure nonprofits are paid on time and in full.

Investing in #supportivehousing doesn't just mean building new units. 9K+ first-generation units are at risk of going offline without support from @GovKathyHochul and the NY state legislature. For supportive housing to be effective, we must protect our current tenants.
